Teaching:

1. Administrative Law: Each state seeks to achieve the general needs of the members of society, so a group of bodies works to provide these needs, which may be individual activities aimed at profit or fame, including administrative activities for which the executive body or the so-called public administration is responsible, where it provides the needs with a view to the public interest. Administrative law communicates with the public administration, which usually consists of employees and bodies who exercise the state's administrative function to achieve public needs. Hence the importance of administrative law, as it is linked to the public interest, and the following are the most important applications provided by administrative law.

Accordingly, the administrative law under a general definition states that it is a set of legal rules whose function is to regulate the

relationship of the public administration with individuals, and the relationship of the various administrations among themselves, and it is a set of rules that organize and govern the activity of the public administration through the means and privileges that the administration possesses in order to satisfy public needs.

2. Administrative Judiciary: The Administrative Judiciary plays a very important role in monitoring the legality of administrative actions and protecting the rights and freedoms of individuals, by separating the cases before it. The administrative judiciary derives this importance from its natural function as the official body that imposes the rule of law on all bodies and whoever its status, location and nature as it imposes the rule of law on all bodies, whatever their status, location and nature.

It is not possible to establish these concepts in reality without the role of the administrative judiciary, since the administrative dispute is one of the parties to an administrative authority that may be a central, administrative, or local authority or a public facility of an administrative nature and the subject of the dispute is related to an issue of public interest.

3. Labor and Social Security Law: A law that affects the vital interests of a large group of the population is the workers who constitute the overwhelming majority of the working population who perform subordinate work under the authority and supervision of the employer. The Labor Law regulates the working relationship between workers and employers under individual and collective (collective) work contracts. between employers and the labor organization) and the aim of which is to protect the rights of both the worker and the employer, so the law establishes obligations and rights on each of the two parties to the relationship and achieve sustainable development. Human rights and basic freedoms, organizing the work of foreigners in Iraq, and implementing labor agreements, whether Arab or international, provided that they are ratified.

As for the Social Security Law, this law aims to protect workers and provide comprehensive coverage in all emergencies and life circumstances that threaten people's ability to earn income and their ability to maintain an acceptable standard of living. This

includes benefits in the event of unemployment, sickness, work injuries and disability. Pregnancy, childbirth, old age, providing for poor children, widows and divorced women, subsistence aid, and comprehensive medical care.

The importance of the Social Security Law lies in that it provides a source of income for man to preserve his dignity and prevent him from begging and begging people and raising the national economy through the establishment of projects and investments, the operation of security funds and the creation of various job opportunities to employ the unemployed.
